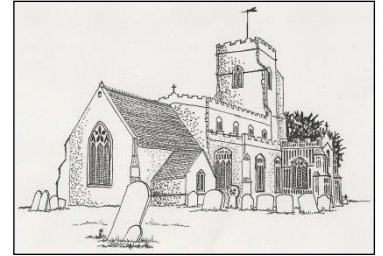

The Churches

Besides one CofE church in each parish, both fine mediaeval Grade I listed buildings, in Lavenham the only other denomination with a worship centre in the village is the Salvation Army which has a large hall with good facilities overlooking The Common.

There are a number of Roman Catholics who worship in nearby Sudbury, Clare (with its Augustinian Priory), Lawshall and Bury St Edmunds.

We have good ecumenical relations and do a number of things together each year including a shared Lent course, a joint Remembrance Service, a summer Songs of Praise and a special service for the Week of prayer for Christian Unity.
